## LAW

The rules of Redeemer Lutheran School are based on what is found in Scripture. "Love the Lord your God with all you heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength."

The second is this: "Love your neighbor as yourself." There is no commandment greater than these." Mark 12:30 31, tells us what we should do, the 10 Commandments add what we should not do.

1. You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God.

We should fear and love God so that we do not curse, swear, use satanic arts, lie, or deceive by His name, but call upon it in trouble, pray, and give thanks.

When in prayer, song, worship, and Bible time we will honor God by using His name and listening to His Word with reverence and respect.

2. Honor your father and your mother.

We should fear and love God so that we do not despise or anger our parents and other authorities, but honor them, serve and obey them, love and cherish them.

We will honor our teachers and those in charge by showing them respect, using good manners, and being obedient.

3. You shall not murder.

We should fear and love God so that we do not hurt or harm our neighbor in his body, but help and support him in every physical need.

We will be in control of our body at all times so that we do not hurt ourselves or those around us.

4. You shall not steal.

We should fear and love God so that we do not take our neighbor's money or possessions, or get them in any dishonest way, but help him to improve and protect his possessions and income.

We will ask permission from others before taking or borrowing their things, and make sure we return them in the same condition.

5. You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.

We should fear and love God so that we do not tell lies about our neighbor, betray him, slander him, or hurt his reputation, but defend him, speak well of him, and explain everything in the kindest way. We will work to be peacemakers and use kind words when we talk to or about our friends.

## **GOSPEL**

"For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life." John 3:16

The Gospel of Jesus Christ tells us we are forgiven through faith in what Jesus did for us on the cross. Jesus took our punishment, and took our sins away. The Holy Spirit uses the Gospel message to change our hearts to want to obey and follow Jesus. When we fail to follow God's commands, He forgives us for the sake of His Son, Jesus.
